### In the spotlight at night with Salvo Sottile

An Indian community from just outside the Italian city of Latina who gather in a temple at night; a man dressed as a tiger who organizes sex parties; a broker from Florence who wakes up at the same time as the international markets; bingo loving ladies caught between the excitement of the game and the shadow of the underworld; and a friendly “lamp lighter”: these are the leading lights of the night who met Salvo Sottile during the first episode of “Prima dell’alba” (“Before Dawn”), which was broadcast on the Italian channel Rai 3 at 11.10 pm on 19 March 2018.



Over the course of six episodes, the journalist Salvo Sottile will meet fascinating nocturnal figures and talk about their personal and professional experiences, on a journey that will go all of the way across Italy from North to South and will always end when the sun rises.

There are engrossing and desperate stories to be told. Sometimes they are uplifting and other times they are heartbreaking. They are the tales of people who work out of choice or necessity, people who have fun, people who break the rules, people who break the law, people who start living when everyone else goes to bed, and people with jobs that cannot be done in the day. The stories often go untold on our TV screens but they have been revealed thanks to the journalistic approach and curiosity of someone who wants to paint an authentic picture of a hidden side of Italy that is often



forgotten or ignored. The aim is to offer a fresh perspective on Italy and Italians.

But why are we telling you all of this?

Because a key role at the Siderforgerossi Group is played by people who can be found in our forging, heat treating and mechanical processing departments at night. The story of Siderforgerossi by night

will be shown on our TV screens during episode 5, which will be broadcast on Rai 3 at 11.10 pm on 16 April 2018.

The report was filmed in mid-January 2018 on the Arsiero site and as well as describing the activities that we perform, it will feature interviews with our colleagues who take centre stage at night.
